


2008 SYRAH - PATINA VINEYARD Otis Kenyon

The 2008 vintage was the perfect one to start making a Syrah designated from the Patina Vineyard. This dry farmed vineyard has been an integral part of our Syrah since 2006 and has always added wonderful acidity and amazing earth tones.

Now on its own, that acidity is creating an extremely food friendly wine that pairs beautifully with rich thick triple creams or steak frites smothered in a cognac demi-glaze.

Hints of freshly fallen leaves, caramel and Italian plum make this the perfect wine to cuddle up with this Autumn.
