


2009 PETIT VERDOT Otis Kenyon

Otis Kenyon Wine's inaugural Petit Verdot is an inky and complex offering. It is filled to the brim with flavors from South East Asia – from cumin to clove, roasted sweet carrots to fully formed yellow curry. These amazing and unique layers are complimented with baking chocolate, rose hips and cedar. A bright and slightly tart persimmon pops up in the mid palate, mellowing out to smooth fresh fig jam.

This wine will be long lived with our best guess for optimal drinking being 2014 – 2022, but being ready to explore by Spring of 2012.
