


2009 SYRAH Otis Kenyon

Starting right off with aromas of smoke, rich cocoa nibs, earth and cinnamon, this is a dark and brooding Syrah from Otis Kenyon Wine. By swirling it in the glass (or a little more bottle time) it opens up to wonderful fruit: blackberry softening to blueberry, then great floral components and eventually lightening all the way to herbal eucalyptus.

The inky color and great structure – both acid and tannin – convey the dark start to this wine but the bright Rainer cherry and creamy milk chocolate smooth out the mouth feel, creating a complex and thoroughly enjoyable Walla Walla Valley Syrah.
