


2010 PETIT VERDOT Otis Kenyon

Otis Kenyon's second Petit Verdot starts out very traditionally with its inky dark pomegranate color, but quickly diverges from the norm with scents of blackberry cobbler, red currant, roasted peaches and caramelized onions. With so many big aromas right off the bat it takes a moment for the light rosebud and fresh nectarine to become apparent.

The flavors are just as intense with fat black cherry and rich dark chocolate filling your mouth. This wine is so decadent you'll want to skip dessert and just have another glass.
