Smooth and well-integrated. Offers currant and spice flavors, shaded with hints of herb and tobacco as the finish lingers against plush tannins, picking up a sweet oak note on the aftertaste. Drink now through 2015. 475 cases made. -HS

Pure Cabernet Sauvignon from Pepper Bridge and Seven Hills goes into this elegant, crisp and nicely balanced wine. It is quite a change from the winery's 2004, which used different vineyards and (seemingly) a different mix of barrels. This shows varietal fruit-red currant, cherry and plum-and details of leaf and herb. Some pickle barrel spice can be found on the finish, probably from the 31% new American oak. -
