2005 is our second Cabernet Sauvignon release. It spent 18 months in 32% new French oak, 31% new American and 37% in neutral oak. 473 cases were produced and bottled at our Walla Walla Valley winery.

This classic Walla Walla Valley Cabernet introduces itself with inviting dark cherry, licorice and coffee aromas wrapped around playful blueberry and lavender notes. Juicy plum and currant balance plush tannins and a smoky finish. This wine rewards familiarity and will continue to soften with age.
